

**Lakeview Park
Campground Rules**

1. Campground permits can be acquired from the Leisure Services Office in the R.M. building or the caretaker in person or by reservation.
2. All campground permits must be paid in full on entry to the campground. Reserved sites will only be held for five (5) days until fees are received.
3. Directly following registration, the camping unit must be located on the campsite ("Camping unit" means any tent, tent-trailer, camper truck, trailer or other form of movable, temporary accommodation).
4. Seasonal camping sites are neither transferable nor refundable. The renting, subletting or assigning of camping units, camping privileges or campsites is not permitted.
5. Seasonal renters are responsible for maintaining their site. Keeping the grass cut and garbage picked up is their responsibility.
6. Where space is available on the designated site, the permit holder may set up a screened tent for meals or an additional two (2) person pup tent for those identified in the permit as belonging to the group.
7. Maximum of two (2) vehicles are allowed on your designated site. Boat and trailer combinations will be allowed providing space is available.
8. Campground visitors must park their vehicles in designated visitor parking areas.
9. Campsite is not to be altered, enlarged or modified.
10. All pets must be kept leashed, tied up, caged or under physical control at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
11. Rowdiness and/or excessive noise are not permitted at anytime. This includes fighting, playing loud music, using insulting or obscene language, drunkenness, etc. Quiet time is 11:00 pm.
12. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only on designated sites.
13. Fires are prohibited except in designated firepits and should be kept small and under control.
14. Fireworks are strictly prohibited in the campground.
15. Persons responsible for a disturbance or a violation of these rules may receive written warnings. Serious or repeat violations may result in eviction from the campground and possible prosecution for offences. All fees are non-refundable.
16. Refunds for reservations will be given with a minimum of 24 hours notice.
17. To avoid individuals booking the entire campground and then not using it, the reservation of a maximum of two campsites per person is allowed.
