Volleyball games will start on Wednesday February 22 and run every Wednesday until March 21. The length of the program will depend on how many teams register.

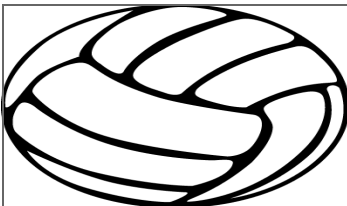
Time: 7:00 pm
