Happy New Year. Let Leisure Services help you put some fun and fitness into the year.

Join us at the Communiplex on January 10 for our first Family Fun Day—the **2010 ShOlympics**—beginning at 1:00 pm! Compete for medals and prizes in the following ShOlympic events:

Hockey—Sign up your team for 3-on-3 hockey (3 players, 1 goalie) in the following categories: 6-10 years, 11-15 years, and family teams which must include at least one player under 15 years. Hockey equipment required.

Ice racing—Races will be held in the following categories: Under 6 years, 6-8 years, 9-11 years. Helmets required.

Curling—Adults grab your favorite kid; kids grab your favorite adult for the 2-on-2 curling bonspiel.

Wii Ski Jumping—Adult and youth categories. Use the Wii remote and Nun-chuk to slide down the takeoff ramp and jump as far as you can go.

Wii Snowboard Half-pipe—Adult and youth categories. Zig-zag through the course, jump at the edge



of the halfpipe and perform tricks.

Wii Skeleton—Adult and youth categories. Be the quickest to slide through the winding course in your sled.

Other events being planned include a family bingo, horse-drawn wagon rides and an outdoor weiner roast. Participate in as many events as you like or cheer your favorite athlete on. The medal ceremonies will commence following the presentation in honour of Ken Ewachewski at 6:00 pm.
