

Lakeview Park Campground Rules

1. All campground fees must be paid in full to the office, attendee or in the drop box prior to departure.
2. Check in time is 3:00 pm and check out time is 11:00 am unless the site is unoccupied or the lot is not reserved.
3. Where space is available the camper may set up an additional dining tent and sleeping tent on the site.
4. Maximum of two (2) vehicles are allowed on your designated site.
5. Campground visitors must park their vehicles in designated visitor parking area.
6. All unauthorized vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.
7. Campsite and fire pit are not to be altered in any way. Fire pits are not to be moved. Fires are allowed in the pits only and should be kept small and under control. All garbage must be bagged and placed in garbage cans. Recycling boxes are available and must be respected. There is only one fire pit allowed per site.
8. All pets must be kept leashed, tied up, cages or under physical control at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Barking dogs or those causing a disturbance will be dealt with promptly. Campers who don't contain their pets will be asked to remove them.
9. Quiet time is 11:00 pm - 7:00 am. Excessive noise or rowdiness is not permitted at anytime. Failure to comply will result in persons being removed. You are responsible for the behavior of anyone (visitors, campers) visiting your site. All visitors are bound by campground rules.
10. Alcoholic beverages may be consumed only on designated sites. Glass containers are not permitted off designated campsite. Lakeview Park is a family campground and we ask our guests to be respectful.
11. Fireworks are strictly prohibited in the campground.
12. Refunds for reservations will be given with a minimum of 24 hours notice.
13. When booking the entire campground, fees must be paid in full. Cancellations two (2) weeks or less prior to the will result in half the fees being kept.
14. Under no circumstances is Lakeview Park liable for injury to persons, including their guests or invitees or for loss of property damage due to fire, theft or accident. Guests must determine to what extent of insurance is required to protect themselves and guests against such a loss.

15. Damage to or defacing of property will result in financial penalty.
Uncontrolled destructive children or youth will not be tolerated by management and may result in their being banned from the Park or you eviction. Children without adequate supervision may be asked to leave the area.
16. DISREGARD FOR RULES, STAFF OR OTHERS WILL RESULT IN YOUR REMOVAL.
